Through **PolioPlus**, Rotary's most ambitious program to date, Rotary has played a leadership role with the World Health Organization, the US Centres for Disease Control and Prevention, and UNICEF in bringing the world to the brink of polio eradication. Rotary's **END POLIO NOW** campaign promotes public awareness and fundraising for the program.

The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation has given Rotary \$355 million in challenge grants to support **PolioPlus**, and has pledged up to \$35 million per year more through 2018 for the final push to eradicate the disease worldwide.
